

## Haydn's Anniversary

This year marks the 200th Anniversary of the death of Joseph Haydn, a composer whose genius is all too often overshadowed by his lively contemporary, and friend, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. To honour the occasion, Aradia presents a concert of Haydn's choral and vocal works.

The Mass Fragment *Missa Sunt Bona Mixta Malis* will be the world premiere, in a reconstruction by Kevin Mallon. The bitter-sweet *Salve Regina* in E Major was written when Haydn's love Terese Keller chose to enter a convent rather than marry. The concert concludes with the glorious *Lord Nelson Mass*, so called because of Napoleon's recent defeat by British Admiral Horatio Nelson.

G. F. Handel Messiah in Original Version, Dublin 1742

*"It is requested the Favour of the Ladies not to come with Hoops this Day to the Musick-Hall in Fishamble Street. The Gentlemen are desired to come without their swords".* Such was the request in the Dublin Journal on April 13th, 1742 for the performance of Mr. Handel's new Sacred Grand Oratorio, the Messiah. Aradia's presentation is a reconstruction of this first performance. We expect our audience to remember Patrick Delany's reaction on hearing "He was Despised" sung exquisitely by Mrs. Cibber, a contralto of questionable morals when he exclaimed, *"Woman, for this, thy sins be forgiven thee!"*

Aradia continues its exploration of the theatre music of Henry Purcell, presenting the original text alongside music for the plays, hence the composer's music for *Don Quixote*, will be presented with excerpts from Thomas D' Urfey's play. Likewise for *Bonduca*, or *The British Heroine* excerpts from John Fletcher's play will be heard. Purcell was the supreme master of combining natural speech rhythms with poignant melodies.

When he married his music to the poetry of the finest writers of his day, the results were beyond compare. This concert is surely not to be missed!

Mezzo Soprano Marion Newman is the daughter of Kwagiuth chief Victor Newman, a master mask carver. This concert is designed to be centered around the Newman family legend of the Thunderbird which has been passed for generations.

A Thunderbird mask carved by Victor Newman will be accompanied by dancer Jason Taylor and his father George Taylor, singing traditional songs with hand drum. Aradia will contribute bird inspired music from the Baroque Era including, Jacob Van Eyck's Engles Nachtegealitje, William William's Sonata in Imitation of Birds and Vivaldi's Spring. The concert will conclude with a new work by Timothy Isherwood, meshing Native themes with Baroque Music for all the performers.
